Get connected: Join LSO's e-newsletter list or become our friend on Facebook to be the first to know about upcoming events and special ticket offers.

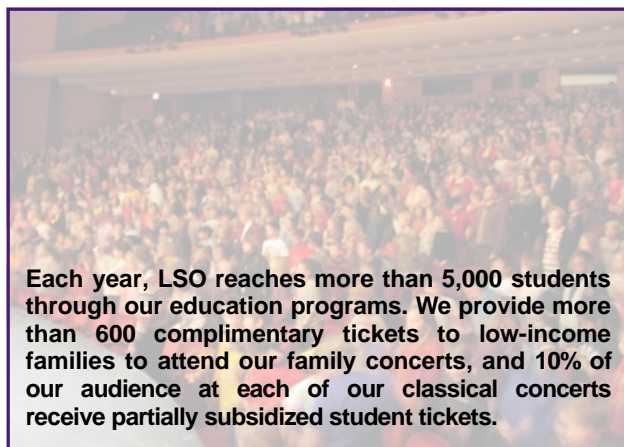
## WHERE CAN I PARK?

**Kimball Recital Hall**, between 11th and 12th & R streets, is just north of the **Lied Center for Performing Arts** on the University of Nebraska-Lincoln downtown campus. Parking is available at several downtown garages, including Que Place (11th & Q streets), Market Place (10th & Q streets) and Haymarket Garage (9th & Q streets). **NEW THIS YEAR:** Pre-pay for your LSO event parking online at [www.lincolnsymphony.com](http://www.lincolnsymphony.com).

**O'Donnell Auditorium** is located on the campus of Nebraska Wesleyan University. It is inside the Vance D. Rogers Center for Fine Arts on the northeast corner of 50th and Huntington. Parking is available streetside or in lots on the northwest and southeast corners of 50th and Huntington.

**Each year, LSO reaches more than 5,000 students through our education programs. We provide more than 600 complimentary tickets to low-income families to attend our family concerts, and 10% of our audience at each of our classical concerts receive partially subsidized student tickets.**

## WHERE CAN I EAT BEFORE THE CONCERT?

LSO has partnerships with downtown restaurants Misty's (476-7766), Green Gateau (477-0330), Red9 (477-7339) and Dish (475-9475). Make advance reservations and show your LSO ticket to receive special discounts.

## WHAT CAN I DO WITH MY TICKETS IF I AM UNABLE TO USE THEM?

Although LSO ticket sales are final, season subscribers may exchange tickets (no later than 48 hours prior to performance) for tickets of equal or lesser value to remaining concerts in the current season, subject to availability, or make a tax-deductible contribution by donating the tickets to LSO.

**As members of the not-for-profit sector, orchestras depend on a combination of private philanthropy and civic support - and every piece is critical. Orchestras are not supported by ticket sales alone. Last year, LSO patrons like yourself contributed over \$70,000 to our Annual Fund Campaign.**
